THE ROLE

We are currently recruiting for an experienced CNC machining centre setter/operator required to set and operate 3 axis CNC machines fitted with 4 and 5 axis trunnions. They must be able to read and understand ISO programs and where necessary do editing of existing toolpaths on programs as well as adjust offsets and modify speeds and feeds. Any programming experience will stand them in good stead. The production operative will be required to work safely on a number of machines or processes and where necessary, training will be provided to ensure safe working practice is maintained.
